### Supplied by the competitor:

- **OPTIONAL:** A personal computer (laptop preferred) with computer aided drafting and design software. Competitors should ensure that software licensing will work without an



internet connection in the competition space outside of the competitor's school's location and outside of the competitor's school's normal calendar year. SkillsUSA is not responsible for computers, or any property left overnight in the competition space.
